SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING READING TEACHER
Revised Guidelines for Implementation (National Level)

1. The following procedures shall be followed in selecting the National Winners for the SORT:

a. The National SORT Committee (NSC) shall conduct a pre-evaluation of the supporting documents on June 4-8, 2007.

b. The final selection shall be conducted by a panel of judges with an interview on June 26-27, 2007.

c. After which, the NSC shall determine the Grand Winner, First Runner-Up and Second Runner-Up from among the 17 finalists.

2. The 17 Regional finalists shall each receive the following prizes:

- ▶ Cash Prize of P10,000.00
- ▶ Plaque of Recognition
- ▶ Plaque of Recognition for the School, Division and Region where the winner comes from

3. The National winners shall receive the following prizes:

Grand Prize

- ▶ Trophy
- ▶ Cash Prize of P75,000.00
- ▶ Plaque of Recognition for the School, Division and Regional Office
- ▶ Books for the school worth P25,000.00

First Runner-Up

- ▶ Trophy
- ▶ Cash Prize of P50,000.00
- ▶ Plaque of Recognition for the School, Division and Regional Office
- ▶ Books for the school worth P25,000.00

Second Runner-Up

- ▶ Trophy
- ▶ Cash Prize of P30,000.00
- ▶ Plaque of Recognition for the School, Division and Regional Office
- ▶ Books for the school worth P25,000.00

SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING READING TEACHER

A. **Criteria for Assessment of Supporting Documents (60%)**

Note: This assessment comprises 60% of the overall percentage points for determining the Outstanding Reading Teacher. This should be computed with the rating of the interview.

I. Performance Level **35%**

Performance rating for the past three years should at least be Very Satisfactory (VS) as evidenced by:

- Performance Rating
- Class performance in Phil-IRI and reading tests (last 2 years)
- Testimonials (from students, peers, supervisors)

II. Professional Development **30%**

- Active membership in professional organizations related to the teaching of reading (i.e. RAP, ACEI, IRA, PASATAF)
- Officer of any of the professional organizations mentioned above
- Units in graduate school
- Attendance in training programs/conferences
 - ✓ National Level
 - ✓ Regional Level
 - ✓ Division Level
 - ✓ School Level

III. Performance Research/Publication/Creative Work **20%**

- Instructional materials produced like books, workbooks, modules (published or with certification)
- Paper presentation/demo teaching/best teaching practices/ action researches
- Published articles
- Prototype lesson plans prepared
- Teaching innovations presented/undertaken to address Phil-IRI results
 - ✓ National Level
 - ✓ Regional Level
 - ✓ Division Level
 - ✓ School Level

IV. Community Service **15%**

- Civic or religious activities with proper documentation
