

DEPED SINING PAMBANSA
(Integrated National Culture and Arts Program in Basic Education)

To: Undersecretaries
Assistant Secretaries
Bureau, Center and Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepED) is convening a Planning Workshop to develop an Integrated National Culture and Arts Program in Basic Education on June 3-7, 2007 at the Boso-Boso Highlands, Antipolo City.
2. The DepED Sining Pambansa fulfills DepED's vision to make "every learner to be functionally-literate, equipped with life skills, appreciative of arts and sports, and imbued with the desirable values of a person who is *makabayan, makatao, makakalikasan at maka-Diyos*".
3. Further, the Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) seeks to bring out the multiple intelligences of the student thru culture and the arts which is a good avenue to develop the spatial, musical, kinaesthetic, interpersonal and intrapersonal intelligences. Thus, a strong culture and arts program contributes to the child's over all development.
4. To draft and plan for the Integrated National Culture and Arts Program in Basic Education, a Technical Working Group (TWG) will be convened to be participated by representatives from the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), MAPEH Regional Education Supervisors, selected Principals of Schools with Special Program for the Arts (SPA), SPA Teachers with specialization in theater, dance, visual arts, creative writing, music and resource persons from Culture and Arts Institutions and Organizations. Enclosed is the List of Participants.
5. The expected outputs of the Technical Working Group are the following:
 - a. Draft an Integrated National Culture and Arts Program in Basic Education (*Sining Pambansa*);
 - b. Plan a *Sining Pambansa* Festival, both a competition and a showcase that will involve all the divisions and regions:
Philosophy, Activities, Participants, Budget, Outputs and Outcomes;

- c. Plan and draft the rationale, structure and operationalization of the Arts Club as a co-curricular organization in the elementary and secondary levels;
 - d. Discuss the livelihood opportunities, tourism potentials and career placement of culture and arts in the areas of visual arts, performing arts, creative industries and others; and,
 - e. Report on the status of implementation of the Special Program for the Arts (SPA) and plan other related Culture and Arts activities.
6. The Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) shall be the convener of the *Sining Pambansa* and shall serve as the Secretariat of the Technical Working Group (TWG). Expenses for this activity such as board and lodging, extra-duty allowance of speakers/facilitators and other expenses shall be charged against OSEC funds. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against the funds of their respective Bureaus, Centers, schools, division and regional offices.
