Theme: **“CREATIVITY IN NEEDLECRAFT**

A. Guidelines:

1. Home Economics as an art calls for enhancement and innovativeness/creativity in the teacher and student skills with good work ethics
2. The Needlecraft Competition is open to third year and fourth year for both boys and girls in public and private schools.
3. All contestants will compete in the division category.
4. All division contestants will compete in the regional level. Each region will only have one student winner and one mentor winner.
5. All regional winners will compete for the national level on October 26 – 28,2007 during the PHEA Convention at Grand Men Seng Hotel, Davao City
6. Contestants are required to attend the briefing/ orientation with the contest administrator two hours before the contest proper.
7. Both teacher and student will wear their school uniform for the whole duration of the contest.
8. All contestants must register to the contest administrator immediately after the briefing, by presenting the certification from the Superintendent and Regional Director.
9. Focus Global Inc. will provide all materials for free, except individual sewing box and the blouse to be embroidered
10. Bring cotton or linen blouse: Blouse should be white with collar and sleeves for the contestant to embroider.
11. Only authorized persons are allowed to stay at the contest venue during the competition.
12. The number assigned through raffle system identifies each contestant as well as sequencing of assignments.
13. The contest date is on October 27,2007 from 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 Noon / 1:00 – 5:00 P.M. including snacks and lunch break at the Convention venue. Evaluation starts 5:30 P.M.
