SEAMEO-RECSAM SCHEDULE OF COURSES FOR FY 2007-2008

1. The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization-Regional Center for Education in Science and Mathematics (SEAMEO-RECSAM) in Penang, Malaysia, in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED), announces the regular courses for Fiscal Year 2007-2008.
2. These scholarships are extended to senior educators and teacher-trainers in the elementary and secondary school levels. All courses are of four (4) week duration with only one (1) scholarship slot per course.


4. Applicants should possess the following basic qualifications:
- Must have a degree in Science or Mathematics education;
 - Must have a minimum teaching experience of five (5) years;
 - Must not have availed of a similar training or scholarship program in the last two (2) years;
 - Must be in excellent health;
 - Must not be more than fifty (50) years of age at the time of availment of the scholarship;
 - Must have knowledge of basic computer application programs;
 - Must be a LET or PBET passer/eligible and with a permanent appointment; and
 - Must be good at spoken and written English to get the maximum benefit from the course.

5. The submission of nominations together with the nominees' transcript of records, performance ratings for the last three (3) years, latest service record, medical certificate fro a government medical officer, certification of no pending administrative or criminal case, photocopy of baccalaureate diploma, certification of English proficiency, personal data sheet (CS Form 212) and endorsement from the Regional Director shall be guided by the following deadlines:
