CALENDAR OF ACTIVITIES AND PERIODS OF CERTAIN
PROHIBITED ACTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE
SYNCHRONIZED ELECTIONS OF BARANGAY AND
SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OFFICIALS ON OCTOBER 29, 2007

Promulgated: 08 August 2007

The Commission on Elections, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines, the Omnibus Election Code and other election laws, **RESOLVE** to prescribe, as it hereby prescribes, the following calendar of activities and periods of prohibited acts in connection with the October 29, 2007 Synchronized Sanguniang Kabataan and Barangay Elections:

Campaigning (Sec. 3, OEC) Soliciting votes or undertaking any propaganda for or against any candidate or any political party within the polling place of within thirty (30) meters thereof (Sec. 261 (CC) (6), OEC) Selling, furnishing, offering, buying, serving or taking intoxicating liquor, etc. (Sec. 261 (dd), (1), OEC).

		refreshments, within thirty (30) mcters radius from the polling place. (Sec. 261 (dd) (2), OEC). Giving and/or accepting free transportation, food, drinks and things of value. (Sec. 89, OEC)
		Holding of fairs, cockfights, boxing, horse races or similar sports. (Sec. 261, (dd) (3), OEC)
October 30, 2007 (TUE) to November 28, 2007 (WED)	Filing of sworn statements of election contributions and expenditures.	

The Executive Director and the Deputy Executive Director for Operations shall immediately implement this Resolution.

The Education and Information Department is directed to cause the widest dissemination of this Resolution and its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.

This Resolution shall take effect on the seventh (7th) day after its publication.
