FIRST NASSPHIL NATIONAL CONGRESS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The National Association of Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NASSPHIL) Inc., in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), announces the holding of the **First NASSPHIL National Congress** on April 6-9, 2008 at Teachers Camp and Convention Center, Baguio City with the theme "Strong Schools United ... The Bulwark of a Strong Nation United".
2. The congress aims to:
  - a. understand the basics and the nuances of the Basic Education School Reform Agenda (BESRA) as a policy instrument of the Schools First Initiative (SFI);
  - b. detail the role and responsibilities of school administrators, teachers and students in the implementation of BESRA goals; and
  - c. have an appreciation of the capability expectations of the association as a united front in the effort to attain institutional reforms in basic education.
3. Participants to this congress are private and public school Principals/Assistant Principals, Officers-in-Charge (OICs), Administrators, and Heads of secondary trade-agriculture-fisheries schools, and since this is an organizational congress, three (3) secondary school teachers, and three (3) incoming secondary school seniors for every schools division. Teacher and student delegates shall be distributed among public, private, and technical-vocational schools in the division. Combinations of teacher and student delegates shall come from the same three schools to facilitate the organization of NASSPHIL in the regions. The schools division superintendents should choose the division's teacher and student delegation as deemed most appropriate to the circumstances of the division.

4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP4,700.00) per administrator including working committee members and Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) per student shall be charged to cover board and lodging, materials and other related conference expenses. Meals shall be served from the supper of April 6 until lunch of April 9. Members of the different committees, as well as the present NASSPHIL officials and Board of Directors are authorized to travel two days before the Congress. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
