**CONSULTATION WORKSHOP ON THE DEPED ICT FOR EDUCATION (ICT4E)
STRATEGIC PLAN AND TRAINING ON THE DEPED REIMAGINED SERIES**

1. The document that defines the Strategic Intent for the 5-year ICT4E Strategic Plan for the Department has recently been completed. The document is a product of collaboration between the Australian Government and the DepED through the AusAid's Private Sector Linkages Programme (PSLP) and assisted by the Queensland University of Technology (QUT).
2. This document is now ready for consultation and ground-up planning over a six-month period (April - October). During this period, the advice and insights of a broad range of stakeholders including students, educators, parents, tertiary institutions and private sector leaders will be sought. A multi-stakeholder consultation is being planned on various dates within July-September 2008. Several clustered regional consultations are being planned in various locations (Northern Luzon; NCR and Southern Luzon; Visayas; Southern and Northern Mindanao; and Central Mindanao, Western Mindanao and ARMM).
3. The ICT4E Strategic Plan is directed towards the students. It aims to lead the students to be proficient, adaptable life-long learners where ICT plays a major role in creating a new and improved model of teaching and learning where education happens anytime, anywhere. The successful implementation of the ICT Strategic Plan for the Philippines will lead to the commencement of exciting new era in education. Such success will require close cooperation among the education stakeholders including the parents and the wider community.
4. The Department recognizes the critical importance of education leadership and stakeholders from plan formulation to implementation. Thus, series of Consultation Workshops on the ICT4E Strategic Plan will be held on specific dates which shall aim to:
 - a. create understanding and appreciation of the opportunities and challenges embodied in the DepED ICT4E Strategies Plan;
 - b. generate constructive feedback, comments and recommendations from the different stakeholders in and outside the department including potential partners; and
 - c. prepare regional and division implementation plans.

5. The training on DepED ReimaginED on the other hand aims to familiarize the regional and division education leadership on the various ICT tools available for them and undergo hands-on exercise on the use of said tools. This training will target the Regional Directors, Assistant Regional Directors, Chiefs of the Elementary, Secondary and Alternative Learning Division of the Regions, and the Schools Division Superintendents or Assistant Schools Superintendents participants in the Consultation Workshop on ICT4E Strategic Plan. The same training will immediately follow after the consultation workshop to save on cost and man hours. The schedule of both activities is enclosed.


6. The list of participants, schedule and tentative program of activities are found in Enclosure Nos. 1, 2 and 3, respectively. Two of the school head participants should be the Regional President of the PESPA for elementary and PASSA for secondary. Likewise, the two of the teacher participants shall be the Regional President of the elementary and secondary teachers association. One parent-participant shall likewise be the President of the Regional Federation of PTCA.

7. Transportation expenses of the participants to the consultation workshop – the teachers, school heads, regional chiefs, regional ICT coordinators as well as resource persons, management, TWG members, facilitators and staff shall be charge against project funds while those of the other regional and division participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.

8. Board and lodging expenses, supplies, materials and contingencies, honorarium for resource persons, convenors and outputs integrator and other related expenses shall also be charged against project funds.

9. Expenses for the ReimaginED Series of trainings shall be partly borne by INTEL.

10. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
