**TELEVISION MODULES FOR LITERATURE CLASSES
AT THE SECONDARY LEVEL**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Foundation for Upgrading the Standard of Education (FUSE) has produced "Continuing Studies via Technology (CONSTEC) on Literature: A Telecourse for Students and Teachers of Literature," a series of 25-minute telelessons intended to enhance the teaching of literature in secondary schools.
2. Each lesson is divided into two (2) parts: the first segment is meant for students and focuses on a literary text; whereas, the second segment is intended for teachers and focuses on the methods of teaching the text.
3. The series has been telecast by ABS-CBN's Knowledge Channel since June 10, 2008 with one (1) lesson being aired per week and repeated on the following time slots:

Education Supervisors are also encouraged to watch the telelessons and conduct group discussions on the lessons with teachers.
