PARTICIPATION TO THE TECHNO-PRESENTATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS
ADVOCACY (Tech-PHRA)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. In connection with the celebration of 60th Anniversary of the Declaration of Human Rights, the UNESCO-ASPnet is launching a nationwide contest entitled Participation to the Techno-Presentation of Human Rights Advocacy (Tech-HRA) with the theme **"Children for Peace and Human Rights"**.
2. The competition aims to:
 - a. develop a sense of awareness among students towards human rights education;
 - b. advocate related innovative activities;
 - c. strengthen youth involvement in the celebration; and
 - d. upgrade their research skills in Human Rights advocacy through power-point presentation.
3. The contest has the following mechanics:
 - a. only one entry per region;
 - b. only one team/representative composed of five (5) student-researchers and one teacher-coach per regional entry;
 - c. each team is allowed to present 15-20 slides excluding the title and details (name of school, researchers and coach);
 - d. power-point presentation of slides should revolve around the given theme;
 - e. upon comprehensive and careful analysis of the judges, three winners will be proclaimed to receive plaque of recognition and cash prizes.
4. The contest is open to all public and private secondary schools.
5. Each region is entitled to conduct elimination of entries and select the best to compete in the national competition. Submission of entries can be coursed through e-mail: renecolocar@yahoo.com on or before November 30, 2008.
