3. Under the NFP, an individual becomes eligible to a short term course only when he/she has been admitted to the university or institute offering such. An admission letter or conditional acceptance does not guarantee final selection since candidates from 57 countries compete for the scholarship.
4. Upon receipt of a conditional admission or acceptance from a university, the individual is advised to immediately notify and submit additional requirements, if required, to the Office of Assistant Secretary Teresita G. Inciong.
5. Nominees shall be notified of the schedule of interview which will be conducted by the Foreign Scholarship Training Program Unit of the Technical and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Pevoti Bldg., TESDA Complex, East Service Road, South Superhighway, Taguig City. Only documents of applicants who passed the pre-selection process will be endorsed to the Royal Netherlands Embassy.
