THIRD PAVEA NATIONAL CONGRESS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools
Technical Vocational Schools
Regional and Division TVE Education Supervisors/Coordinators

1. The Philippine Association of Vocational Education Administrators (PAVEA) in coordination with the Technical-Vocational Education Task Force (TVETF), will hold its Third National Congress of Technical-Vocational School Administrators/Principals at Oxford Hotel, M. Roxas St., corner N. Aquino Avenue, Clark Special Economic Zone, Pampanga on February 26-28, 2009, with the theme "Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education at the Crossroads of Global Economic Meltdown".

2. The congress aims to:

- a. follow-up assessment on the yearly implementation of the Strengthened Technical-Vocational Education Program to determine as to what extent of competencies it provides to technical-vocational students;
- b. identify strategies to help strengthen school's interagency linkages in the pursuit of the school technical-vocational excellence; and
- c. update participants on the plans, programs and projects of the Association and the Technical-Vocational Task Force, DepED.

3. The participants to this congress are schools division/city superintendents/assistant schools division/city superintendents (SDS/ASDS), chiefs, secondary education division, regional and division supervisors of TLE/TVE, heads of private secondary technical-vocational schools, administrators/secondary school principals/officers-in-charge of public secondary technical-vocational schools (Arts and Trades, Agriculture and Fisheries), head teachers of the vocational and related subject departments, and one TVE teacher.

4. Teacher-participants may swap their time schedules with other teachers in the school to avoid disruption of classes. They can offset their absence/s in class with the same number of class upon their return from the congress.

5. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, conference materials, kits, honoraria of speakers, facilitators and other related conference expenses. First meal shall be served dinner of February 25 and last meal will be dinner of February 27. Traveling expenses and registration fee of participants and committee members shall be charged against office/local school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. PAVEA officers and board of directors and designated committee members are authorized to travel two days before the congress proper. Attendance to this congress is on **official business**.
