**TRAINING ON SURVIVAL SKILLS (ALS FEAR FACTOR) FOR MOBILE
TEACHERS AND REGIONAL CORE OF TRAINORS (RCT)**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Public Schools District Supervisors
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Bureau of Alternative Learning System (BALS) will conduct a Special Training entitled "ALS Fear Factor for ALS Learning Facilitators" particularly the ALS Mobile Teachers and Regional Core of Trainors who are in-charge of training, other ALS Learning Facilitators such as District ALS Coordinators (DALSC), Instructional Managers (IMs) and Facilitators in May and June 2009.

2. The aforementioned training was conceptualized to address the nature of work of the abovementioned ALS learning facilitators. Further, considering the nature, work situation and location of the said ALS learning facilitators, the Bureau realizes the importance of providing them the necessary training appropriate for the special task to reach the unreached sector of the society nationwide.

3. The participants shall be the one thousand three hundred eighty three (1,383) ALS Mobile Teachers and eighty five (85) Regional Core of Trainors nationwide. The schedule of the training program is as follows:

5. Expenses relative to the conduct of training such as travel, board and lodging of all participants will be charged to the BALS funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
