30TH ANNUAL NATIONAL GRADE SCHOOL CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI) in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED) will hold the 30th Annual National Grade School Convention on August 27-31, 2009 and the 51st Annual Convention of CMLI Junior Members and Teacher Advisers on October 26-30, 2009 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "Ang CMLI at Kabataan: Pinoy sa Isip, sa Salita at sa Gawa".
2. At the end of the convention, the participants should be able to:
 - a. identify and apply effective technique learned from workshops and symposia;
 - b. exemplify the values learned;
 - c. project a positive attitude as CMLI-er; and
 - d. demonstrate a high level of leadership skills.
3. The highlights of the convention include the following:
 - a. commission discussion and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership training, values formation, interpersonal relations, and effective oral communication;
 - b. cultural performances showcasing individual and collective talents;
 - c. keynote speeches of prominent personalities;
 - d. competitions for excellence, on-the-spot poster making, OPM singing, pop quiz hot shot; and
 - e. workshops, symposia, sportsfest and socials.
4. The participants are the students of public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide, school leaders and active officers and members of the school council, school paper editors/staffers, outstanding honor pupils, officers and members of school-based clubs/organizations who may be

recommended by the school principal and their respective Local Government Units (LGUs). Attendance of public school participants is **on official time only**.

5. A registration fee of Five Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP5,850.00) will be charged per delegate inclusive of board and lodging, convention kit/materials, and other training expenses. Payment in cash is preferred. All checks shall be made payable to CMLI. No personal checks shall be honored. Transportation expenses from point of origin to Baguio and back are not included.
