SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (NSPC) SY 2008-2009**

The Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) hereby announce the results of the National Schools Press Conference (NSPC) for SY 2008-2009 held on February 14-21, 2009 in Naga City, Region V. This culminating activity of the Campus Journalism Program is embodied in DepED Memorandum No. 457, s. 2008 with the theme "Climate Change: A Call for Responsible Campus Journalism".
2. The conference brought together about 4,500 campus journalists, their school paper advisers, division and regional supervisors in-charge of journalism, Elementary and Secondary Education Division Chiefs from the 17 regions, staff and officials from the DepED Central Office.
