UNESCO NEXT GENERATION OF TEACHERS: FIRST PHILIPPINE

1. The University of the Philippines (UP)-College of Education will conduct the UNESCO Next Generation of Teachers: First Philippine Conference on Information Communications Technology (ICT) in Teacher Education on October 26-30, 2009 at UP Diliman, Quezon City.
