JUAN-DAY MATH STORYTELLING AT THE LIBRARY HUB

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. With the end in view of making mathematics teaching/learning meaningful and contextualized in local everyday life setting at the same time encouraging reading habit among high school students, an annual one-day blended math storytelling at each Division Library Hub nationwide will be conducted by the 1981 Presidential Gold Medallion awardee, eDamath/SciDama inventor Jesus L. Huenda, starting SY 2009-2010 dubbed as "Juan-day Storytelling at the Library Hub by the Mathemajess'yan".
2. School Year 2009-2010 will start with the informal morning storytelling session at each Division Library Hub with selected 40-50 Fourth Year high school students and their teacher using the inventor's printed module with indigenous cartoon characters entitled "Max the Matrix & Co." (published by UP NISMED, UP Diliman, Quezon City with permission from SEAMEO RECSAM, Penang, Malaysia). While the afternoon storytelling session is intended for a similar set of Second Year students and their teacher using the inventor's interactive CAI material "Fibo the Frog Mathemajess'yan" (Master in IT Education, PNU, Manila and Asia Pacific College, Makati Consortium, 2002) plus his patent-pending invention eDamath (i.e., player vs. computer, and player A vs player B in LAN platform) in LCD, PC tablet and web cam.
3. Every school year will have a separate set of blended math teaching/learning materials via storytelling with integration on global warming/climate change and consumer education either developed by the said educational technology inventor or harvested via the worldwide web.
4. Travel and other related expenses of math storyteller Jesus L. Huenda are chargeable against OSEC funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations anent Paragraph 2 of DepED Memorandum No. 269, s. 2009 entitled Creation of Project Team for the Library Hub, that is "(2.3) initiate activities for the improvement of the project; and (2.4) develop plans, programs and policies for the project".
