RESULT OF THE JAPAN-EAST ASIA NETWORK OF EXCHANGE FOR STUDENTS
AND YOUTHS (JENESYS) PROGRAM SELECTION FOR 2009

1. Pursuant to DepED Memorandum No. 258, s. 2009 on the AFS Intercultural Programs Philippines Selection Camps, the AFS Philippines is pleased to announce the passers of the Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youths (JENESYS) Scholarship Program for 2009.
2. These passers, composed of sixty (60) students and six (6) teachers from all over the country, shall participate in the JENESYS Scholarship Program on December 3-17, 2009 in Japan, expenses of which shall be shouldered by the Japanese Government. Each student and teacher, together with counterparts from Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia, India, New Zealand and Australia, will experience a two-week intercultural exchange, study tour of three (3) Japanese cities, and homestay with a Japanese family.
3. Travel of the participants covering November 30 to December 19, 2009 shall be on official business. All participants are required to report to the OMI Retreat Center, Quezon City on November 30, 2009 for the pre-departure orientation and to stay in the same venue until December 19, 2009 after arrival from Japan for the re-entry activities.
4. Student-participants shall be given enough time to prepare for quizzes and other examinations missed during their absence. They shall also be allowed reasonable time to comply with and submit other requirements of the different subject areas.
5. All Regional Directors and the Schools Division/City Superintendents are advised to generously support their respective students and teachers for quality participation and learning.
