

3. Non-dangerous props are allowed

Criteria for Robotics Dance

1. Robot Costume	30%
2. Gracefulness in Robotic Style	40%
3. Stage Presence	10%
4. Coordination	<u>20%</u>
(Performance time 5-7 minutes)

Guidelines in TUGSAYAWIT/SAYAWIT

1. Consist of 15-20 dancers
2. Science oriented presentation
3. The entry include tugtugan, awitan and sayawan for secondary (TUGSAYAWIT)
4. The entry include awitan and sayawan for elementary (SAYAWIT)
5. Accompaniment of music from cassettes, CD's and others is allowed.

Criteria for TUGSAYAWIT/SAYAWIT

1. Mastery	25%
2. Coordination	25%
3. Costume	25%
4. Stage Presence	10%
5. Science Implications	<u>15%</u>
