7<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL CONVENTION ON DEAF EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Department of Education through the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, in coordination with the LINK Center for the Deaf, Foundation for Professional Development, Inc. (FAPDI), and the National Association of Special Education (NASE), Inc. will hold the 7<sup>th</sup> National Convention on Deaf Education on May 17-19, 2010 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The theme of the convention is "Inclusion: Public Support and Empowerment".

2. The objectives of this convention are to:

- a. provide a forum for persons involved in deaf education to share their expertise/experiences and exchange ideas;
- b. address the needs of persons with hearing impairment through effective teaching strategies;
- c. encourage deaf persons to relate their trials and successes which may make them models for the deaf community; and
- d. pave the way for a better future for the deaf through public support for inclusion and empowerment.

3. Participants to this activity are Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of Elementary and Secondary Education Divisions, Schools Division Superintendents/Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Regional and Division Supervisors of SPED, Heads of Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools, Regular and Special Education Teachers, and Speech Therapists. Attendance of public school participants shall be on **official business**.


4. A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) will be charged each participant to this live-in convention. The fee covers accommodation, meals from dinner of Day 0 to pm snacks of Day 3, kit and honoraria for resource speakers. Expenses incident to the participation of DepEd staff may be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. Participants from private schools/institutions shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective schools/offices.

5. The tentative Program of Activities is found in Enclosure No. 1 while the Abstract of Presentation is in Enclosure No. 2. Those interested should submit the Abstract (Part II) on or before March 31, 2010.
