- 1. The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the National Committee will hold the **Dance Xchange: 2nd International Dance Workshop and Festival** on April 14-20, 2010 in Roxas City, Capiz. This year's theme is "Cultural Connectivity Through Dance".
