SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONS

I. The schedule of activities is as follows:

March 11	-	Arrival (After Lunch) Get-Together with the Vice President (3:00 PM)
March 12	-	Awarding Ceremonies (8:00 AM)
March 13	-	Social Events
March 14	-	Departure (After Breakfast)

- II. Except those coming from the National Capital Region, the AWARDEES and their authorized companions are expected to be in Manila on March 11-14, 2010. Free accommodation and meals shall be at the GSIS Hostel, Pasay City which shall start dinner of March 11 and end breakfast of March 14. - III. For purposes of meals and accommodation at the GSIS Hostel, the AWARDEES are authorized to bring along **only three companions of the students' choice, preferably the teacher-adviser, school principal/head and parents/guardians.**
- IV. The awarding ceremonies will be held on March 12, 2010 (Friday) at the Heroes Hall, Malacañan Palace, Manila from 8:00 AM – 12:00 NN with Vice President Noli de Castro and Secretary Jesli A. Lapus in attendance.
- V. For the awarding ceremonies, the AWARDEES may invite up to ten (10) guests provided they submit a list on or before March 8, 2010 to the DepED-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs. Those who are not in the list will not be allowed entry in Malacañang Palace.
- VI. AWARDEES are required to be in their school uniform during the activity with the Vice President on 11 March 2010 (Thursday) at 3:00 PM at the Office of the Vice President and during the awarding ceremony on 12 March 2010 (Friday) at 8:00 AM in Malacañang Palace. The AWARDEES are also required to prepare a two-minute acceptance speech.
- VII. The AWARDEES' companions/guests during the Awarding Ceremonies must dress appropriately. Slippers, rubber shoes, collarless and sleeveless shirts, *maong* pants and shorts are not allowed.
- VIII. Concerned School Principals and Schools Division Superintendents are advised to find ways to assist AWARDEES' parents/guardians relative to their transportation expenses by helping them solicit funds from local government units or private organizations, if needed. It is important that the parents/guardians of the AWARDEES be present during the Awarding Ceremonies.
