SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE FLAG AND HERALDIC CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

- 1. Cognizant to the significance of the National Flag Day and the 112th Anniversary of the Proclamation of Philippine Independence, this Department in cooperation and coordination with the Heritage Institute Center (HIC) and the National Historical Institute (NHI) will hold a seminar-workshop on the Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines at the regional, division and district levels pursuant to DepED Memorandum Nos. 154, s. 2008 and 245, s. 2009 respectively. See Enclosure No. 1 for the Schedule of the Seminar-Workshop, which is year-round activities and every year thereafter.
- 2. The main aim of this activity is to educate the public on the Rules and Regulations Implementing Republic Act No. 8491.
- 3. The objectives of this activity are to:
 - a. promote public awareness in instilling values such as love of country, respect for the Flag and sense of patriotism and nationalism through this project;
 - b. instill in the hearts and minds of the youth the pride of being a Filipino and their native land;
 - foster continuing respect for the Filipino Flag and the use of national Anthem imparting it deeply into national consciousness;
 - e. enable educators to properly sing and conduct the Philippine National Anthem based on Republic Act No. 8491 in all occasions here and abroad.
- 4. All public schools may send at least two (2) of their teachers and or coordinators of Filipino, Social Studies/Sibika, MAPEH/MSEP, Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (Values Education)/GMRC, or CAT commandants/advisers, and boy and girl scouts advisers/masters. The private schools are invited to send high school, grade school, and preschool administrators and teachers in the same field mentioned above.



- 5. The seminar fee is Three Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PhP3,200.00) for National Capital Region (NCR) participants and Three Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP3,700.00) for participants provincial workshops. This fee includes the honoraria for the speakers, complete workshop kit (*Lupang Hinirang* CD, Music Book, Lesson Exemplars on the Flag and Anthem, *Isang Watawat*, *Isang Awit*, *Isang Bansa* Story Book, Wall Chart of the Anthem Lyrics, Pitch Pipe, Envelope bag, and Advocacy ID, RA No. 8491, and Philippine Flag (optional), two (2) snacks, lunch and other lecture materials. Pre-registration and payment in cash are encouraged. However, payment in the form of check shall be payable to Heritage Institute Center.
- 6. The first batch of this year's seminar-workshop was held at ISO Complex, Ateneo de Manila University, Quezon City on Monday, April 19, 2010. Please see Enclosure No. 2 for the Program of Activities and Enclosure No. 3 for the Registration/Confirmation Slip.
- 7. Travel expenses and seminar fees of public school participants shall be charged to local funds (such as but not limited to region, division, school MOOE, local school board funds or from civic spirited clubs and organizations) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations while the participants from the private schools shall make financial arrangements with their respective schools/institutions.
