2010 INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICS EDUCATORS CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Mathematics Trainers' Guild (MTG), Philippines in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) will conduct the 2010 International Mathematics Educators Convention with the theme, "*Making Sense: Teaching and Learning Math by Understanding*" on October 21-24, 2010 at the Royale Tagaytay Club, E. Aguinaldo Highway, Buck Estate, Alfonso, Cavite.

2. The convention aims to:

- a. acquaint the mathematical community with the latest trends in mathematics with special emphasis on the methodology, Understanding by Design (UbD);
- b. enrich teachers with innovative strategies for meaningful and fun-filled mathematics class;
- c. provide an opportunity for mathematics teachers to exchange ideas with their colleagues in the national and international levels; and
- d. exchange experiences, discuss issues arising from international mathematics education and discuss new models of mathematics education in the 21st century.


3. The participants to this activity are mathematics coordinators/department heads, supervisors, and teachers of elementary and secondary public and private schools from the Philippines and from other Asian countries such as China, Malaysia, Indonesia, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and Singapore among others.

4. A registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (PhP6,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for accommodation, conference materials, meals, and for the travel expenses and honoraria of the following renowned international mathematicians as resource persons:

- a. **Prof. Wen-Hsien Sun**, President, Chiu Chang Mathematics Education Foundation, Taipei, Taiwan;
- b. **Prof. Peter Taylor**, Executive Director, Australian Mathematics Trust;
- c. **Dr. Ridwan Hasan Saputra**, President/Director, KPM Math Clinic, Indonesia;
- d. **Dr. Lee Shen Hong**, Chairman, China Mathematical Olympiad;



- e. **Prof. Pinky Leung**, Principal, Hong Kong Mathematical Olympiad School;
 - f. **Dr. Pramote Kajornpai**, Director, Innovation in Primary and Secondary Education, Ministry of Education, Thailand; and
 - g. Local Mathematics experts.
5. A reservation fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) is to be deposited at BPI-Zamboanga Branch at MTG Philippines Peso Current Account No. 2111-0214-68. Deposit slip and registration form must be sent at e-mail address: rjd182001@yahoo.com indicating the name and address of the depositor.
6. The registration fee, travel and other incidental expenses of each participant shall be charged against local/school fund subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Local participants who pay the registration fee in full on or before September 1, 2010 will be entitled to a 10% discount. Participation is on a first-come, first-served basis since many foreign mathematics teachers/educators have expressed willingness to attend. The organizers cannot guarantee a place to any interested person who has not paid before September 1, 2010.
