**CONDUCT OF THE DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES OF THE MOTHER TONGUE-BASED
MULTILINGUAL EDUCATION (MTB-MLE) FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2010**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Mother Tongue-Based Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE) for the Elementary Level Program announces the conduct of activities on the following dates, and venues:

2. The activities aim to:

- a. enhance the knowledge, skills, and attitudes of trainers in the MLE methodology who are confident to model MTB-MLE teaching methods and train other teachers;
- b. develop competent, creative, and resourceful MTB-MLE teachers who can provide relevant learning opportunities and experiences to their life-long literate and numerate learners;
- c. implement a strong MTB-MLE program in some selected schools in the region;
- d. inculcate awareness among the participants on the development of love and respect for the heritage, culture, mother tongue, national language, and contribute to the development of their own communities and the nation;
- e. develop a training system that provides regular in-service training and continuing capacity development for trainers, teachers/mentors' mobile teachers (BALS), and instructional leaders;
- f. design their training materials for results-driven capacity development, and instructional leaders in the MTB-MLE; and
- g. craft/develop monitoring and evaluation tool to track the development of their MTB-MLE activities.

3. Board and lodging, transportation expenses, supplies and materials, honoraria of resource persons, instructional materials and other incidental expenses shall be charged against OSEC-HRTD funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



4. To facilitate the financial transaction of the program, Ms. Mayumi H. Tomelden is hereby designated as MTB-MLE Special Disbursing Officer.
