1. ## **TEACHERS' MONTH CAMPAIGN AND WORLD TEACHERS' DAY**

### **ESSAY-WRITING AND POEM-WRITING CONTESTS**

#### **MECHANICS**

##### **I. RATIONALE**

This Essay-Writing and Poem-Writing Contests are part of the various activities nationwide for the Teachers' Month Campaign which will culminate on 5 October 2010 designated by UNESCO as the World Teachers' Day.

##### **II. THEME**

The theme of the contests is "My Teacher, My Hero".

##### **III. OBJECTIVES**

The contests seek to achieve the following objectives:

- a. To encourage elementary pupils and high school students to creatively express how much they honor and value their teachers; and,
- b. To instill awareness and drum up support for the Teachers' Month Campaign and World Teachers' Day celebration.

##### **IV. CONTEST GUIDELINES**

###### **A. General Guidelines**

1. The Contests are open to bonafide elementary pupils and secondary students from both public and private schools nationwide.
2. Each pupil/student/school shall submit only one entry per contest.
3. The essay or poem must be original and previously unpublished.
4. It must be written in English and aligned with the theme, effectively conveying the writer's thoughts on why he/she regards a particular teacher his/her hero.
5. The essay or poem must be headed by a title.
6. The essay or poem must be emailed and accompanied with the following information:
  - a. Complete Name
  - b. Contact Number, Preferably Mobile Number
  - c. Home Address
  - d. Grade/Year Level
  - e. Name of School
  - f. School's Contact Number
  - g. School Address
  - h. Full Name of Teacher who inspired the Essay, along with his/her Complete Home Address, School Name and Address, Contact Numbers and state whether living or dead.
7. Deadline of submission of entries shall be on 24 September 2010.

8. The winning entries will be featured in the Smart Schools website (**www.smartschools.ph**) and in publicity releases in major newspapers nationwide.
9. The Department of Education and Smart Communications, Inc. reserve the right to reprint the winning entry in a future publication. The writer may republish the unedited submission as desired six months after initial publication by the contest organizers.
10. Decision of the Judges is final and irrevocable.

B. Specific Guidelines

1. Essay-Writing Contest

- a. All English subject classes, beginning 1 September 2010, shall conduct an essay-writing activity as part of the requirements of the subject utilizing the theme of the celebration.
- b. From among the outputs made in all classes, the English Department Heads and Teachers shall select the school's entry.
- c. The school's entry must be emailed to **essaytmc2010.depedsmart@gmail.com** with the information indicated and required in Item IV-A-6.
- d. The entry must also be accompanied with a signed Certification/Honor Pledge of the School Principal that the pupil/student is a bonafide pupil/student of the school; that the entry is an original composition of the pupil/student; that it was specifically written for the 2010 Teachers' Month Campaign and World Teachers' Day; that the entry has not been submitted to any other essay-writing competition; that the pupil/student has not received any assistance in composing the essay; and that the entry has been adjudged the winner following an essay-writing activity in all English classes.

2. Poem-Writing Contest

- a. The poem must be composed of a maximum of three (3) stanzas with four (4) lines per stanza.
- b. If there is more than one entry, the school, thru the English Department Head or Teacher shall select from among the entries.
- c. The school's entry must be emailed to **poemtmc2010.depedsmart@gmail.com** with the information indicated and required in Item IV-A-6.
- d. The entry must also be accompanied with a signed Certification/Honor Pledge of the School Principal that the pupil/student is a bonafide pupil/student of the school; that the entry is an original composition of the pupil/student; that it was specifically written for the 2010 Teachers' Month Campaign and World Teachers' Day; that the entry has not been submitted to any other poem-writing competition; that the pupil/student has not received any assistance in composing the poem; and that the entry has been selected by the school.
