**SEARCH FOR THE 2010 OUTSTANDING SCIENCE CLUB
ADVISERS OF THE PHILIPPINES**


To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 28, declaring September of every year as the National Science Club Month (NSCM) and authorizing the Department of Education (DepED) to implement plans and activities in celebration thereof, this Department through the Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) and the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP), in cooperation with ABS-CBN-DZMM and the Philippine Science Journalists Association (PSciJourn), are conducting the **Search for the 2010 Outstanding Science Club Advisers of the Philippines**.
2. The Search aims to achieve the following:
 - a. Promote Science consciousness and public understanding of Science, Technology and Environment in the grassroots level;
 - b. Highlight the importance of the role of the Science Club Advisers in the management of Science Clubs in schools and their significant contributions in the community through relevant programs, projects and activities; and,
 - c. Recognize exemplary performance of Science Club Advisers in the elementary and secondary levels throughout the country.
3. The Search is open to all public and private elementary and secondary Science Club Advisers in the country affiliated with the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP). The Guidelines, Entry Form and the Format for Projects, Activities and Awards are found in the Enclosure Nos. 1, 2 and 3 respectively.
4. The DepED-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) and the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) are authorized to promote, support and monitor the conduct of the Search in all levels. Incidental expenses of the Division and Regional Selection Committees shall be charged to their respective local funds.
5. The Division and Regional Offices, through the Science Education Supervisors/Coordinators, are required to organize a selection committee. The Regional Science Education Supervisor shall submit a consolidated report indicating the list of the winners in both the division and regional levels and all the participating Science Club Advisers, name of originating schools and their addresses, name of the School Principal and the SCAAP Chapter President to the DepED-CSCA on or before **September 17, 2010**.
6. All Regional Directors, Schools Division/City Superintendents and School Heads/Principals are enjoined to actively support the Search.

GUIDELINES

I. RATIONALE

The search for the Outstanding Science Club Advisers of the Philippines is a nationwide search that aims to recognize exemplary and outstanding Science Club Advisers in the country. These are the Science Club Advisers who made significant contributions to the advancement of science education; promoted science leadership and community service through their conduct of and participation in science and technology-related activities or who contributed to or motivated pupils/students' participation in environmental protection and conservation through co-curricular organizations or inspired pupils/students to pursue science-related activities.

As we celebrate the National Science Club Month every September of the year, it is but appropriate to give due recognition to the Science Club Advisers so they may serve as models and inspiration for the science clubbing movement.

II. MECHANICS

- A. The Search is open to Science Club Advisers in both public and private elementary and secondary levels under one category.
- B. The Science Club Advisers must be affiliated with the Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP)
- C. Interested Science Club Advisers must submit the following requirements:
 - 1. Duly accomplished Entry Form contained in Enclosure No. 2;
 - 2. Complete list of officers and advisers of the SCAAP Division Chapter;
 - 3. SCAAP Local Chapter Constitution and By-Laws, Organizational Structure, Logo/Seal and Club Handbook (if applicable);
 - 4. List of projects and activities conducted from June 2007 to May 2010, including a brief description of the project/activity, venue and duration of the project/activity, participants and beneficiaries, level or scope of the project or activity, and cooperating agencies (refer to Enclosure No. 3);
 - 5. List of science activity/projects participated by the club or its members, officers, and/or advisers in the national, regional, division and community level including various conferences being conducted by SCAAP and DepED (such as the SCAAP Conferences, YES Camp) and other related science activities from June 2007 – May 2010 with brief description of each activity, level of participation, proof of awards and certificates received;
 - 6. List of Awards/Citations received by the club or its advisers/officers while doing activities related to the club from June 2007 – May 2010 with brief description of award/citation, agencies/organizations giving the award and photocopy of certificate/plaque or certification.

7. Other supporting documents, such as but not limited to photographs, video coverage, newsletter/newspaper or school paper clippings or certifications; and,
8. Other documents with the adviser may deem meritorious during the evaluation.

III. GUIDELINES

A. The following criteria for judging shall be employed:

B. The following shall be adopted in the selection and judging of the entries:

1. Selection shall follow a three-level process; namely Division, Regional and National Selection.
2. All interested Science Club Advisers shall submit their application and other documents direct to the Division Office on or before September 3, 2010.
3. A joint Division Selection Committee composed of the Schools/City Division Superintendent, Science Education Supervisors of both elementary and secondary, including two representatives from the private sector shall be organized to select a winner in the Division Search.

4. Only one division winner shall be selected. The Division Selection Committee shall forward the name of the winner and his/her documents to the Regional Office on September 10, 2010. The Regional Selection Committee is composed of the Regional Director, Assistant Regional Director, Regional Science Education Supervisors of both elementary and secondary and two representatives from the private sector.
5. Only one regional winner shall be chosen. The regional winner is eligible to complete in the National Search. All documents shall be forwarded to, and received by, the DepED – Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), Ground Floor, Mabini Building, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City on or before September 17, 2010.
6. The National Selection Committee shall review all regional winners. It shall be composed of representatives from the DepED-CSCA and SCAAP, including three (3) individuals nominated for their involvement in science clubbing and science education.
7. The National Selection Team may conduct an ocular validation of activities of the top five (5) winners in their respective areas or subject the finalists to a panel interview.
8. The decision of the Selection Committee is FINAL and IRREVOCABLE.
