**CHANGES IN DEPED MEMORANDUM NO. 215, S. 2010
(Seminar-Workshop on the Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines)**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

1. To educate the public on the implementing rules and regulations of Republic Act (RA) No. 8491 which instills love of country, sense of patriotism and nationalism among the Filipino youth, the Department of Education (DepEd) in cooperation with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) and the Heritage Institute Center (HIC), is conducting an advocacy workshop nationwide.

2. In line with this, DepEd Memorandum No. 215, s. 2010 entitled "Seminar-Workshop on the Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines" was issued. However, Paragraph Nos. 4, 5 (Sentence No. 2) and 7 and Enclosure No. 1 (schedule of seminar-workshop) of said Memorandum are hereby changed and shall read as follows:

Paragraph 4. *Public and private school (elementary and high school or college) teachers and coordinators in the following subject areas: Filipino, Social Studies/Sibika/History, MAPEH/MSEP, Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga (Values Education)/GMRC as well as CAT Commandants/Advisers, and Boy and Girl Scouts Advisers/Masters are encouraged to attend the workshop on the revised dates and venues stipulated in the enclosure of this Memorandum.*

Paragraph 5. *(Sentence No. 2). This fee includes payment for the honoraria of the speakers on the Anthem (Dr. Raul Sunico, Prof. Lemuel Dela Cruz, Prof. Herminigildo Ranera or their alternates), complete workshop kit such as the Lupang Hinirang CD, Music Book, Lesson Exemplars on the Flag and Anthem, Story Book, Wall Chart of Anthem Lyrics, Pitch Pipe, Envelope Bag and Advocacy ID, a copy of RA No. 8491, and Philippine Flag (optional), two (2) snacks and lunch, and other lecture materials.*

Paragraph 7. *Travel expenses, board and lodging of the six (6) speakers, six (6) management staff, modest honoraria of the speakers/lecturers on the Heraldic Code of the Philippines and its IRR (Atty. Josefina DV Saliva, Mr. Teodoro S. Atienza, and Prof. Flocerfida G. Faustino), supplies and other lecture materials, documentation and communication shall be charged to OSEC Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel expenses and seminar fees of the public school*



participants shall be charged to local funds (such as but not limited to region, division, school MOOE, local school board funds or from civic spirited clubs and organizations) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations while the participants from the private schools may make financial arrangements with their respective institutions.
