**2010 MOTHER TONGUE-BASED MULTILINGUAL EDUCATION  
(MTB-MLE) DATA BASE SURVEY**

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. As it was agreed during the Training of Trainers (TOT) for Mother Tongue-Based Multilingual Education (MTB-MLE) conducted on September 12-22, 2010 at the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP), Tagaytay City, the following should be submitted for data base survey (see enclosed):

**a. School Mapping**, which is the survey on the different schools, divisions and regions implementing the following:

- Lingua Franca (existing, non-existing)
- Mother Tongue (MT) (refers to the 2009 expansion of the Lingua Franca school/s)


**b. Language Mapping**, which is the survey on the language/s spoken as Mother Tongue (L1) and Lingua Franca (language used by majority of the people in the community and/or common language used for communication in the community) of the school. This survey should be done to both students/pupils and teachers.

**c. Teachers Mapping**, which is the survey on the number of Pre-school and Grade I teachers who are targeted to participate in the regional training in summer 2010 and 2011.

2. These reports are expected to be received by the Office of Undersecretary for Programs and Projects **on or before October 29, 2010**.
