**PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSE ON TEACHING SPANISH
 AS A FOREIGN LANGUAGE (SFL)**

To: Bureau Directors
 Directors of Services, Centers and Heads of Units

 Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), in collaboration with *Instituto Cervantes*, Manila and *Universidad D Salamanca*, Spain shall conduct a **Professional Development Course on Teaching Spanish as a Foreign Language** intended for teachers of Spanish at *Instituto Cervantes*, Manila and DepEd ECOTECH Center, Sudlon, Lahug, Cebu City on October 25-29, 2010.

2. The training aims to capacitate the Spanish teachers on the following:

- a. Linguistic command of Spanish in grammar and vocabulary aspects from a functional and communicative approach;
- b. Available resources to integrate contents on culture in SFL class;
- c. Methodological approaches for teaching-learning SFL and offering patterns for the design and implementation of activities;
- d. Communicative competence of the major skills such as reading, writing, listening and speaking; and
- e. Spanish culture and civilization, in order to contribute to a better understanding of the country and its people's way of life.

3. The teacher-participants from the selected pilot and expansion schools (see Enclosure No. 1) except National Capital Region (NCR) shall be provided with board and lodging at the Philippine Normal University (PNU) Hostel (see Enclosure No. 2), and DepEd-ECOTECH Center following the schedule below:

The board and lodging and traveling expenses of the participants shall be charged to Human Resource and Training Development (HRTD) Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The Ministry of Education of Spain shall shoulder the professors' fees, travel and accommodation of expert professors from *Universidad de Salamanca* while *Instituto Cervantes* shall provide the venue and facilities in Manila.

5. The traveling expenses of the participants shall be reimbursed at the training venue upon presentation of complete supporting documents (travel order, official receipt, plane/boat/bus ticket where applicable, etc.). The NCR participants shall likewise be provided with traveling expenses at an allowable rate per day. Participants are advised to take the cheapest means of transportation.

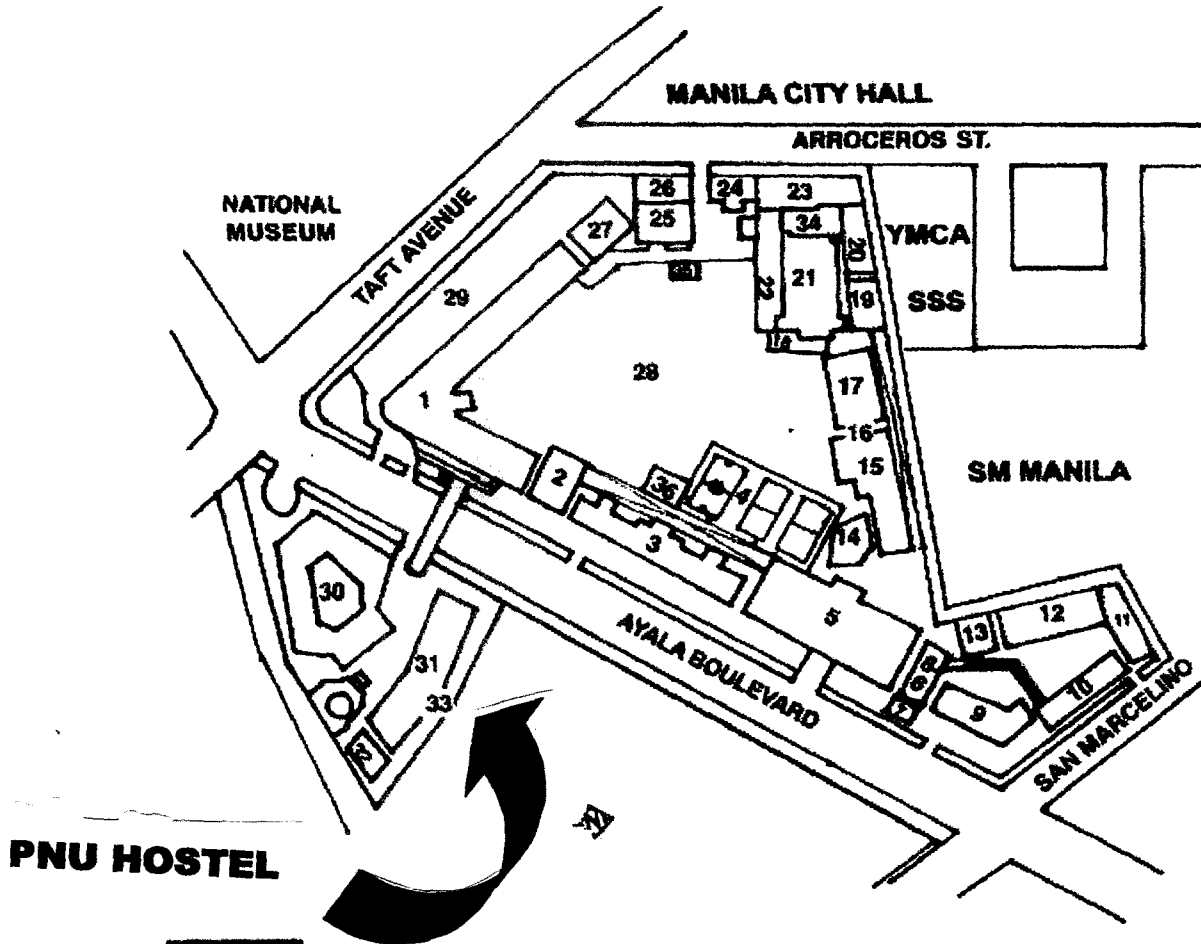
