**INTEGRATION OF YOUTH EMPLOYMENT AND MIGRATION (YEM) CONCEPTS  
IN YEAR I OF CP-TLE CURRICULUM, AND TRAINING OF TEACHERS,

  - enrich understanding of the participants in teaching safe migration, gender sensitivity and life skills;
  - enhance the skills of the participants in teaching the integrated curriculum;
  - determine the application of safe migration, gender sensitivity and life skill concepts and learning tools in the component areas of CP-TLE; and
  - identify strategies in teaching the said integrated curriculum.
