**CLUSTER-TRAINING ON CHILD FRIENDLY SCHOOL SYSTEM-
DROPOUT REDUCTION PROGRAM (CFSS-DORP IMPLEMENTATION)**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools
All Others Concerned

1. In view of the high dropout rate in the secondary level, the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) through its Dropout Reduction Program shall conduct five (5) cluster training on DORP Implementation within the framework of the Child Friendly School System (CFSS). The target beneficiaries are the fifty (50) priority divisions under the Support to Philippine Basic Education Reform (SPHERE) including the divisions piloting the Quality Assurance and Accountability (QAA).
2. The cluster training aims to:
 - a. develop school capacity in identifying students-at-risk of dropping out (SARDOs) using the FICS (Family, Individual, Community and School) analysis tool;
 - b. enable the participants to adopt and adapt to different modalities under the DORP which will best address the needs of the SARDOs;
 - c. introduce various mechanisms and support system to sustain the program implementation including entrepreneurial activities in the school; and
 - d. formulate a simple school DORP plan to be integrated in the School Improvement Plan (SIP).
3. The list of target participants, and proposed schedules and venues of the activity per cluster are enclosed.
4. Participants in the training are advised to bring pertinent and updated data on performance indicators covering at least three (3) consecutive years. Likewise, prototype monitoring and evaluation tools and student tracking system if available are requested. School heads must bring their SIP and Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) of the current school year.
5. Board and lodging, supplies and travel expenses including airfare of reasonable amount and other allowable expenses of participants and guest resource persons shall be charged to BESRA-SPHERE funds. Travel documents such as approved authority to travel or travel order, plane/bus/boat tickets, among others to support the reimbursements are necessary.
