**9TH ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE SCHOOLS DISTRICT
SUPERVISORS' ASSOCIATION (PSDSA)**

1. The Philippine Schools District Supervisors' Association (PSDSA) will hold its **9th Annual Convention** with the theme "*Instructional Leadership: A Challenge to the District Supervisor in the 21st Century*" on November 24-26, 2010 at the Narciso Ramos Sports Civic Center, Lingayen, Pangasinan.
2. The convention aims to:
 - a. articulate with clarity the new roles and functions of district supervisors within the context of DepEd vision and goals;
 - b. enhance competencies and capabilities on how to provide quality instructional supervision and leadership;
 - c. orient and equip them on interconnectivity for fast delivery of educational services;
 - d. give due recognition/incentives to the district supervisors with outstanding contributions to the educational system;
 - e. develop or conceptualize District Education Plan; and
 - f. foster deeper relationships and camaraderie among the district supervisors.
3. All schools district supervisors, principals-in-charge of the districts and officers-in-charge (OIC) are authorized to attend to this live-in convention/seminar **on official business**.
4. The convention shall be managed by the PSDSA through the different committees and the secretariat shall be authorized to travel one (1) day before the convention.
5. The registration fee of Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (PhP3,600.00) shall be charged to each to participant and committee members to cover three (3) days and two (2) nights accommodation with meals and snacks, honoraria for resource speakers, materials, handouts, kits, supplies and other related expenses. Payments may be made in cash or check in the name of the PSDSA.
6. Expenses such as registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses relative to the convention may be charged to available local PSDSA funds and/or general funds made available by provincial, city and municipal budgets, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



7. The regional/division presidents are requested to confirm the number of attendees from their respective region and division on or before November 15, 2010.

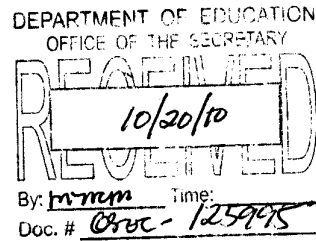
