CONVENTION OF GUIDANCE COUNSELORS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The National Association of Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NASSPHIL) in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) will conduct the **Convention of Guidance Counselors** with the theme, *"The Role of Guidance Counselors Towards Transforming Secondary Schools Into Caring and Nurturing Learning Communities"* on November 17-19, 2010 at the New El Grande Hotel, Alta Tiera Subdivision, Tabuk Suba, Jaro, Iloilo City.

2. At the end of the convention, the participants should be able to:

- a. identify the roles of guidance counselors as provided for in Republic Act No. 9258;
- b. identify the potential roles and functions of guidance counselors towards the realization of schools into caring and nurturing learning communities;
- c. assess their school's Guidance Program based on the goals of the Child-Friendly School System (CFSS); and
- d. map out a comprehensive Guidance Program that will address the guidance needs of Filipino adolescents.

3. The participants to this convention are guidance counselors from both public and private schools and those designated to perform the functions of guidance counselors. The public school participants shall attend **on official business**. All participants are requested to bring a copy of their school's Guidance Program and its Program of Activities for School Year 2010-2011, data on cases handled or referred and results of psychological tests and/or achievement tests.



A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) will be charged to each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, CD, certificate of participation and other incidental expenses. Registration and billeting shall start at 11:00 a.m. of November 17. The first meal will be p.m. snacks of November 17, and the last meal will be lunch of November 19, 2010.

5. Travel expenses and registration fee of the public school participants shall be charged to local school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private schools shall make arrangements with their school administrators.
