THIRD NAPSSPHIL PRINCIPALS CONGRESS

1. The National Association of Public Secondary Schools of the Philippines (NAPSSPHIL), Inc., in coordination with the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) announces the holding of the **Third NAPSSPHIL Principals Congress** with the theme, "*Unity: A New Chapter for the Filipino ... for the School ... for the Nation*" on January 21-23, 2011 at the Bohol Tropics, Tagbilaran City.
2. The congress aims to enable the participants to:
 - a. appreciate the significance and urgency of forging unity among the different sectors of the school community as a channel for attaining national unity;
 - b. understand the elements of unity and their nuances and the channels of attaining it for the school, the community, and the nation;
 - c. lay the groundwork for a strategic approach to fostering unity among school principals, teachers, parents and students; and
 - d. award top performing public secondary schools of the Philippines in the National Achievement Test (NAT) results and other performance indicators.
3. The participants to this live-in congress are public secondary school principals/secondary school head teachers/teachers in-charge and vocational school administrators. The assistant schools division superintendents in-charge of secondary schools and the chiefs of the regional secondary education division may attend at their option. Attendance of the participants including the working committee members shall be **on official business**.
4. The registration fee of Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (PhP3,600.00) per participant, including working committee members shall be charged to cover board and lodging, materials and other related congress expenses. Members of the different committees, as well as the present NAPSSPHIL officers and board of directors are authorized to travel two (2) days before the congress. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged to local funds, subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The environmental tour will be on the third day of the congress but it will be optional on the part of the participants and expenses shall be charged to personal funds.
