DepEd MEMORANDUM

MANILA BUSINESS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

1. The Manila Business College (MBC), Sta. Cruz, Manila in cooperation with the Department of Education (DepEd) is offering a Bachelor's Degree Scholarship Program for deserving sons and daughters of permanent DepEd employees.

2. The MBC offers a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration Major in Marketing, Management, Economics, Human Resources Development and Banking and Finance.

3. Under the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed between MBC and DepEd, the DepEd shall gather, pre-screen and endorse one hundred (100) nominees for scholarships. There are two (2) types of MBC Unlimited Scholars: Scores and Corresponding Scholarships. The applicants with 85% to 95% and above partial general average can avail of any of the following scholarship grants:

- a. 95% and above general average, Dr. Thomas Chua Scholarship Grant (Chairman's Scholarship) with 100% Free Tuition Fee worth approximately PhP150,000.00,* and 100% Free Miscellaneous Fee worth approximately PhP75,000.00;* and
 - b. 85% to 94% general average, the MBC Scholarship Grant for College Scholarship with 100% Free Tuition Fee worth approximately PhP150,000.00.*
- * depending on the chosen course

4. Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- a. Form 138/137;
- b. Birth Certificate (Photocopy of NSO issued);
- c. Certificate of Good Moral Character;
- d. 2x2 and 1x1 pictures (2 copies each); and
- e. Accomplished application form.



5. Applicants should submit the requirements to Ms. Nerissa Losaria, Chief, Staff Development Division, Human Resource Development Service (SDD-HRDS), Scholarship Committee Secretariat **on or before January 15, 2011.**
