**CHIEF GIRL SCOUT MEDAL PRESENTATION CEREMONY
OF THE GIRL SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES**

To: Regional Directors

1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) will conduct its annual **Chief Girl Scout Medal Presentation Ceremony** on November 4, 2016, 1:00 p.m., at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) Complex, Pasay City. The program of this ceremony is detailed in Enclosure No. 1.
2. GSP offers programs which are meaningful and responsive to young women's needs and interests. One of these is the Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme (CGSMS), a special program created in 1975 encouraging Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts who are 15-17 years old to initiate and implement a one-year community project focusing on health, cultural heritage, livelihood, and ecology in their respective barangays. Now on its 40th year, the Chief Girl Scout Award remains GSP's most prestigious Award. To date, it has awarded a total of 9,318 Medalists. This year, GSP will honor 758 young women from all over the country who have successfully undertaken various community development projects under the Scheme. The number of medalists by region (council) is listed in Enclosure No. 2.
3. Around 3,700 guests from all over the country, including the awardees, their parents, troop leaders, GSP officials, and community members, will witness this joyous and memorable event.
4. In view of this, Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts who are high school students and who will be awarded during the ceremony will be excused from their classes. Moreover, chaperones of awardees (troop leaders/teachers and school officials) are permitted to attend this event on **official time only**.
