

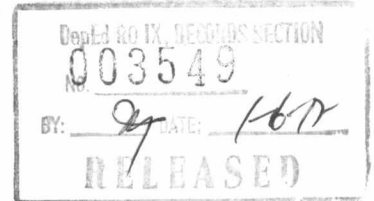

ADDENDUM TO UNNUMBERED REGIONAL MEMORANDUM - DATED DECEMBER 22, 2016
(CONDUCT OF THE 2017 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE)

TO : Schools Division Superintendents
Division Journalism Coordinators
Elementary & Secondary School Principals
This Region

1. Relative to an Unnumbered Regional Memorandum dated December 22, 2016 and released on the same date entitled "CONDUCT OF THE 2017 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE," addendum is hereby made to Paragraph 3.
2. Paragraph 3 of said Memorandum shall then read as follows:

Each participant from both public and private schools shall pay a registration fee of four thousand pesos (P4,000.00). The registration fee shall cover the costs of board and lodging, kits, rental of equipment, vehicle, payment for utilities, contingency and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of the NSPC. The registration fee, including travel and other incidental expenses of participants in going to and from the venue, shall be charged against school MOOE/local/campus journalism fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

3. All other provisions of the said Memorandum still remain in effect.

CONDUCT OF THE 2017 NATIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

TO : Schools Division Superintendents
Division Journalism Coordinators (English & Filipino)

1. Per DepEd Memorandum No. 216, S. 2016 dated December 8, 2016 re: 2017 National Schools Press Conference, the following points are hereby emphasized:
 - a. Online Publishing Contest :Secondary (English & Filipino)
 - For **exhibition** only
 - b. Copyreading and Headline Writing
 - Use **Associated Press (AP)** copyreading symbols.
 - Give the best two headlines for the article.
 - c. Photojournalism
 - Use any digital camera (point and shoot only) with a maximum of **20 megapixels**.
 - Submit 6 shots as official entries.
 - d. Collaborative Publishing
 - Bring at least **2 digital/DSLR cameras**, 1 inkjet printer with scanner, 1 card reader, 1 blank flash drive, extension wires and a maximum of 4 laptops installed with either **PAGEMAKER** or **IN DESIGN** and Photoshop (for Secondary Level) and Microsoft Publisher (for Elementary Level).

 - e. TV Broadcasting
 - Please refer to pp. 33-38
2. For identification purposes, contestants should wear school uniform with valid school IDs during the contest proper.
3. Each participant from both public and private schools shall pay a registration fee of four thousand pesos (P4,000.00) charged to school MOOE/ local/ regional fund/ school campus journalism fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures. The registration fee shall cover the costs of board and lodging, kits, rental of equipment/vehicle, payment for utilities, contingency and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of the NSPC.
4. Delegates are expected to be at the venue on January 22, 2017. The first meal shall be lunch on January 22 and last meal shall be breakfast of January 26, 2017.
5. All delegation officials are requested to wear the following as scheduled:

January 22, 2017 (parade)	– red polo shirt
January 23-24, 2017	– red shirt/ blouse
January 25, 2017	–red polo shirt (SPA)
	red t-shirt (CJ)

Vests should be worn during the whole duration of the NSPC.
