

EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATION FOR THE OFFERING OF SPECIAL PROGRAM IN THE ARTS (SPA) OF CATARMAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, DIVISION OF NORTHERN SAMAR, NORTHERN SAMAR

FINDINGS:

1. It was in SY 2013-2015 when Catarman National High School started to implement the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) up to present offering the six specializations such as Music, Visual Arts, Drama, Media Arts, Creative Writing, and Dance.
2. Record shows that the school has a separate building intended for SPA. It is equipped with functional workshop rooms, laboratories, separate library intended for SPA learners, music and dance studios, and information and communication technology with sink and storage.
3. The school has well-trained and dedicated teachers in the six specializations. Some of them served as national coaches in National Festival of Talents and attended international conferences.
4. The school is under the supervision of the incumbent principal and the SPA is manned by a Department Head who possesses excellent administrative skills and relevant trainings in Music and Arts.
5. The school enjoys the strong support of the generous stakeholders and program partners especially parents and local government officials who fervently willing to extend assistance in the implementation of the Special Programs in the Arts (SPA).

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Based on the evaluation made by the Monitoring Team composed of CLMD and QAAD, Catarman National High School should be granted permission and authority to offer SPA as it has met all the basic requirements reflected in the validation tool.
2. Catarman National High School should be given recognition as a school offering a strong and promising Special Program in the Arts (SPA).


