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

The Special Curricular Programs Division under the Bureau of Curriculum Development and the Indigenous Peoples Education Office (IPsEO) shall conduct the subject workshop on **February 20-24, 2017** at **ECOTECH, Lahug, Cebu City**.

Consistent with the curriculum contextualization efforts under the Enhanced Basic Education Program, as mandated by Republic Act No. 10533, and Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) policies of the Department, the workshop seeks to:

- a) revisit the background, rationale, and process of developing the ALS IP Curriculum;
- b) discuss the IP perspectives that were the basis for the contextualization of the ALS curriculum;
- c) discuss the K to 12 curriculum framework and its implications for ALS, IPEd and the enhancement of the ALS IP Curriculum; and
- d) identify the next steps to be undertaken for the enhancement of the ALS IP Curriculum.
- e) align the existing ALS IP Curriculum with the K to 10 competencies

Each region is requested to send three (3) participants who should be either of the following: a Regional or Division IPEd Focal Person with

involvement/experience in ALS implementation for IP learners, or ALS Coordinator or Mobile Teacher who served/currently serving IP learners.

A copy of the workshop program design is attached for your reference.

Each participant shall be provided with hard and soft copies of the ALS IP Core Curriculum. Participants are advised to bring a laptop, pocket wifi, and extension cord.

Board and lodging and travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged against 2015 BALS GAA fund, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Payment of travelling expenses shall be reimbursed after the submission of complete itinerary documents. Billeting shall start on February 20, with lunch as the first meal. Check out shall be on February 24, with lunch as the last meal.
