
REGIONAL MEMORANDUM

**STRATEGIC PLANNING AND TARGET SETTING WORKSHOP ON
INTEGRATED SCHOOL HEALTH AND NUTRITION PROGRAMS (ISHNP)**

1. The Education Support Services Division through the School Health Section will hold the **Strategic Planning and Target Setting Workshop on Integrated School Health and Nutrition Programs** at RELC-NEAP, DepED RO8 Complex, Government Center, Candahug, Palo, Leyte, on February 27-28, 2017.
2. The activity aims to:
 - discuss, present and harmonize the Regional and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) School Health Annual Implementation Plan;
 - align the harmonized School Health Annual Implementation Plan to the Regional/Division Monitoring Evaluation and Adjustments;
 - set targets on the implementation of the Integrated School Health and Nutrition Programs for the current year; and

5. Meals, snacks and accommodation shall be charged to the Regional School Health training funds while travelling expenses of participants to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
