1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) will hold the **38th Principals Training and Development Program and National Board Conference (PTDP-NBC)** with the theme *Duty, Dignity, Integrity and Determination towards Excellent Principal Empowerment* from May 3 to 5, 2019 at the ASEAN Convention Center, Claro M. Recto Avenue, Clark Freeport Zone, Pampanga.
2. The conference aims to:
  - a. Identify the strategies, skills, traits, and beliefs of effective school leaders;
  - b. Strengthen transparency and shared purposes with parents, staff, community members, and students;
  - c. Enhance effort to conduct professional development opportunities and support services to teachers to become more productive and more engaged in their work; and

5. Arrival and registration of participants will be on May 3, 2019 (Day 1). The first meal to be served will be dinner on Day 1, and last meal will be lunch on May 5 (Day 3).
