**MTAP – DEPED NCR INTENSIVE TRAINING ON CONTENT AND PEDAGOGY
FOR SECONDARY MATH TEACHERS**

TO : SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENTS

1. The Department of Education National Capital Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division in partnership with Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines, Inc.(MTAP) will conduct Intensive Training on Content and Pedagogy for Secondary Mathematics teachers. This will be a 6-day live –out training under the leadership of Education Program Supervisors in Mathematics of the respective schools division and must be held in May 2018.
2. This activity aims to equip teachers with content knowledge in Mathematics sufficient to enable them to know enough of their subject to teach Mathematics better.
3. Attached are training matrix, list of participants and list of trainers.
4. Training materials and other related expenses shall be shouldered by the Mathematics Teachers Association of the Philippines, Inc.(MTAP).
5. Participants are required to attend all the sessions and expected to be at the venue on the first day at 7:30 AM for the registration.
6. The participants, trainers and management staff who will be involved in these activities shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled *Updated Guidelines on Grant o Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*. On the other hand, non-teaching staff shall be provided with Compensatory time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*.
7. CID chiefs are enjoined to monitor the above activity.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
