THE UNESCO-HAMDAN BIN RASHID AL-MAKTOUM PRIZE FOR OUTSTANDING
PRACTICE AND PERFORMANCE IN ENHANCING THE EFFECTIVENESS
OF TEACHERS 2019–2020

The United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has opened the call for nominations on the sixth edition of the UNESCO-Hamdan Bin Rashid Al-Maktoum Prize for Outstanding Practice and Performance in Enhancing the Effectiveness of Teachers, 2019–2020.

Its purpose is to support, encourage, and give benefit to those who are working to enhance the performance and effectiveness of teachers for quality education for all.

The prize, generously supported by H.H. Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al-Maktoum of the United Arab Emirates, amounting to UD\$300,000, is awarded to three winners whose projects aim at improving the performance and effectiveness of teachers worldwide. This prize is awarded every two years.

Candidates may be individuals representing institutions or organizations, international or national governmental or nongovernmental organizations (NGOs), educational or research institutions and local/national/regional communities.

The deadline for submission of nominations for the 2019–2020 Prize is on October 31, 2019 (midnight, Paris time). Applications are to be emailed to teacherprize@unesco.org with the subject line “UNESCO-Hamdan Prize application.” Both application and nomination forms can be downloaded on www.unesco.org/new/hamdan-prize.
