SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON BAMBOO INSTRUMENT MAKING BY THE SILLIMAN
UNIVERSITY CULTURE AND ARTS COUNCIL

The Silliman University Culture and Arts Council, in partnership with the Cultural Center of the Philippines, will hold a Seminar-Workshop on Bamboo Instrument Making from August 7 to 9, 2019 at the Silliman Hall, Silliman University, Dumaguete City. It will be facilitated by Dr. Wu Shin-Yin from the Department of Forestry and Natural Resources of National I-lan University Taiwan (R.O.C.).

The seminar-workshop aims to:

1. introduce the tuning techniques for bamboo instruments,
2. allow the participants realize how bamboo instruments work, and
3. enrich and equip music teachers to the pedagogy of teaching using indigenous music instruments in the 21st century.
