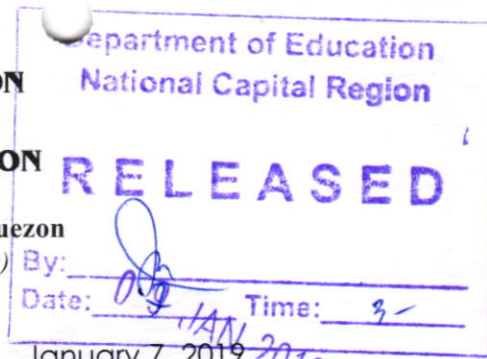

REGIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS ON TEACHER-ADVISER TRAINING PROGRAM

To : Schools Division Superintendents
Regional Chief Education Supervisors
All Others Concerned

1. One of the innovations from the **Bureau of Learner Support Services- Youth Formation Division** is the introduction of the Teacher-Adviser Training Program for Secondary Schools. This training program is an opportunity for the Teacher-Advisers to deliver curricular support for Personal, Social and Emotional Education Development. It involves the intertwined ideals of character formation and academic achievement.
2. The Region seeks to adopt specific support activities that will help promote holistic development among learners, commencing with the Training of Trainers. The conduct of the **Regional Training of Trainers Teacher-Adviser Training Program (TATP) Clusters 1 and 2** will be held on **January 29-February 1, 2019, and February 12-15, 2019**, respectively. Please find the attachments for the specific venue for each Cluster.
3. In macro-level, the program aims to empower responsible, hardworking, service-oriented, value-driven and culturally-rooted teacher-advisers in delivering quality advising and support processes in school and classroom processes that create successful completion.

Specifically, the training aims to:

- a. provide a venue for collaborative and integrative learning for the development of dynamic, feasible and innovative plan of activities for schools
- b. heighten engagement level of teacher-advisers as partners for school and community development towards child-friendly, gender-sensitive, and safe and motivating environment
- c. deepen the understanding of teacher-advisers on learners' holistic development
- d. strengthen the role of teacher-advisers in integrating advising processes and supporting functions in student organizations.

- a. Participants to the training **are the following (as it applies):** Program or District Supervisor, Program Specialists, Project Development Officer 1 (SGOD), Elementary and Secondary Teachers, **who have been handling Project and Organizational Advising for at least 3 years.**
- b. Likewise, they are expected to be in good health, and are computer and technology-literate.
- c. Participants are expected to be at the venue on specified dates, at 8:00 AM.
- d. Please bring pertinent project and organizational data, division and/or school performance indicators, laptops, extension cords, for individual use.

5. The expenses incurred relative to the conduct of this program shall be charged to the regional downloaded fund under **OSEC-NCR-18-9246, while transportation expenses of participants** shall be charged to **Division or School Funds**, whichever may apply, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
