**2nd NATIONAL TECH-VOC DAY**

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development-Special Curricular Programs Division (BCD-SCPD), will celebrate the **2nd National Tech-Voc Day** to promote technical and vocational education and training in the country. This is pursuant to Republic Act No. 10970 **Declaring the Twenty-Fifth Day of August of Every Year as the National Tech-Voc Day**.

2. This year's theme, *Agring-agri sa Pag-unlad sa TVE* (Technical-Vocational Education), will commence with activities that focus on agriculture promotion and aim to:

- a. contribute to the country's inclusive growth and sustainable farming goals by bringing back agriculture in the hearts and minds of learners;
- b. generate support from industries, communities, and various stakeholders in the implementation of agriculture programs, projects, and activities in schools;
- c. help improve the productivity of farmers by involving the youth and community in farming; and
- d. serve as a venue for sharing of good practices on agricultural programs among schools.

3. Through the initiative of regional and division supervisors or focal persons of tech-voc/technical-vocational-livelihood, in coordination with other government agencies, local government units, industries, parent-teacher associations, business partners, and the academe, the following activities that showcase the creativity and skills competence of students in the different areas of agriculture may be conducted at any day from **August 26 to 30, 2019**:

- a. Showcase of agriculture programs and products of schools;
- b. Contests or skills exhibition on farming, food processing, and use of farming technologies;
- c. Set-up of bazaars for the promotion, selling, and marketing of agricultural products;
- d. Conduct of short courses and training on farming and distribution of farmer starter kits for parents and teachers;
- e. Workshops, fora, and technical assistance from agriculture experts/practitioners;
- f. Other activities that have proven multiplier effects.

4. All tech-voc schools are encouraged to conduct activities to celebrate National Tech-Voc Day without disruption of classes, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
