3. provide them with a venue for sharing of experience in integrating information and communication technology (ICT) and other best practices in the teaching of Mathematics; and
4. develop a network of Mathematics teachers, SHs, and teacher-educators who will work together towards excellence in Mathematics Education.

The target participants are regional and division/district supervisors, principals, department heads/coordinators, teachers involved in Mathematics from both public and private elementary and secondary schools and teacher education institutes (TEIs).
