22nd PHILIPPINE MATHEMATICAL OLYMPIAD OF THE
MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY OF THE PHILIPPINES

The Mathematical Society of the Philippines will hold the 22nd Philippine Mathematical Olympiad with the following schedules and activities:

Date and Venue	Activity	Description
October 12, 2019 (Saturday) Regional testing centers	Qualifying Stage	Multiple choice exam for junior and senior high school students which will be administered in each area (Luzon, Visayas, Mindanao, and National Capital Region)
November 16, 2019 (Saturday)	Area Stage	Written competition among the students who topped the Qualifying Stage
January 18, 2020 (Saturday) Metro Manila	National Stage	Written and oral competition among winners of the Area Stage competition

The contest aims to

1. stimulate the improvement of mathematics education in the country by awakening greater interest in, and appreciation of, Mathematics among students and teachers, and gaining insights into levels of mathematics teaching;
2. identify and motivate the mathematically-gifted;
3. identify potential participants to the International Mathematical Olympiad;
4. provide a vehicle for the professional growth of teachers; and
5. encourage involvement of the public and private sectors in the concerted promotion and development of mathematics education.

The target participants are junior and senior high school students.

Participation of public and private schools shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
