

CONTRACT OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION** (**DepEd**), a government agency duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, herein represented by its Undersecretary for Administration, **ALAIN DEL B. PASCUA**, as per DepEd Order No. 67, s. 2016 hereinafter referred to as the "**PROCURING ENTITY**"; and **MR. ARNOLD P. SAYSON**, of legal age, Filipino and with residence and postal address at Blk.151, Lot 25, Paliparan III, Mabuhay City, Dasmariñas, Cavite, 4114 Philippines, hereinafter referred to as, the "**CONSULTANT**";

WHEREAS, the PROCURING ENTITY, through the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS), pursuant to the approved Resolution to Hire Consultant No. 2019-09-ICTS1(007)-BIV-NPHTC-050 on the hiring of highly technical consultant for ICTS, i.e., Consultant Programmer for the Enhancement and Maintenance of PMIS, who shall perform work that cannot be performed by regular personnel of the PROCURING ENTITY, engages the services of the CONSULTANT for the aforementioned purpose.

WHEREAS, the **CONSULTANT** complies with all the required general conditions provided for under section 53.7 and Annex "H" on the Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of R.A.9184.

NOW, THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. DURATION OF ENGAGEMENT

The Contract duration shall, at the most, be **six** (6) **months** from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) by the CONSULTANT, renewable in accordance with section 53.7 and Annex "H" of the IRR of R.A.9184. Contract period extension may be allowed on justifiable grounds as determined by and/or subject to the approval of the **PROCURING ENTITY**; provided, that the Contract period extension shall be at no additional



expense for the PROCURING ENTITY, other than what is stipulated in this Contract.

II. TERMS OF REFERENCE

The **CONSULTANT** shall execute his duties and responsibilities as stated in Clause V of this Contract, and will submit the following required outputs, accomplishment report accepted and signed by the Director IV of ICTS, and supported by validated time sheets, as provided in the Terms of Reference of this Contract:

- System technical design and development strategies 1) to ensure adherence to industry "best practices" and standards:
- 2) Design and development of the applications, data modelling and ERD specifications related to the Project Management Information System (PMIS);
- Formulation of technical design specifications 3) including prototyping.
- B. Provide technical inputs in the development of user's and operations manual.

III. **PAYMENT**

The **PROCURING ENTITY** will pay, subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations, the services of the CONSULTANT in the amount of PHILIPPINE PESOS EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS and 00/100 (Php80,000.00), to be made on a monthly basis based on the accomplishment of assigned tasks; and reporting to the Central Office for eight (8) days per month, subject to applicable withholding tax and submission of accomplishment report and other documents required to justify payment.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

All deliverables, studies, reports or other materials, prepared and/or submitted by the CONSULTANT for the PROCURING **ENTITY**, including the intellectual property rights thereto, shall belong to and remain the exclusive property/properties of the **PROCURING** ENTITY. The **CONSULTANT** PROCURING ENTITY free and harmless from any and all liabilities arising from copyright infringement claims and/or any



other intellectual property claims or suits from third parties relative to the deliverables, studies, reports, or other materials, prepared and/or submitted by the **CONSULTANT**. Immediately upon completion or termination of this Contract, the **CONSULTANT** shall return all copies, files, materials, and any other property in his possession that belong or relate to the interest of the **PROCURING ENTITY**.

V. CONSULTANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The **CONSULTANT** shall report to the DepEd Central Office for eight (8) days per month, and submit required output/monthly report upon accomplishment of the following duties and responsibilities, as stated in the **Terms of Reference** of this Contract:

A. Provide inputs on:

- 1) System technical design and development strategies to ensure adherence to industry "best practices" and standards:
- 2) Design and development of the applications, data modelling and ERD specifications related to the Project Management Information System (PMIS);
- 3) Formulation of technical design specifications including prototyping.
- B. Adjust and enhance existing application components according to agreed upon requirements/adjustments and set development standards;
- C. Test, debug, deploy and document program modules in coordination with the individuals or teams involved in system development, user support, quality assurance, database management, and user support.
- D. Monitor performance and perform fine-tuning of applications;
- E. Document and update as necessary the system architecture or components and programs developed;
- F. Provide technical inputs in the development of user's and operations manual;



- G. On-the-job coaching of the relevant DepEd personnel regarding maintenance of program codes and technologies for programming;
- H. Provision of direct training to DepEd personnel on systems development, improvement, programming/coding, development, improvement, programming/coding, scripting and data retrieval; and
- I. Coach systems owners and relevant DepEd offices on development of programs/scripts and data retrieval.

VI. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

If the **CONSULTANT** fails to satisfactorily perform the Services within the period(s) specified in the Contract inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, the **PROCURING ENTITY** shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the Contract and under the applicable laws, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, the applicable rate of one tenth (1/10) of one (1) percent of the cost of the unperformed portion for every day of delay until the actual performance by the **CONSULTANT**. The maximum deduction shall be ten percent (10%) of the amount of Contract. Once the maximum is reached, the **PROCURING ENTITY** may rescind or terminate the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies available to the **PROCURING ENTITY**.

VII. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Parties shall make every effort to resolve amicably and by mutual consultation any and all disputes of differences arising between the parties in connection with the implementation of the Contract.

Should such dispute not be resolved amicably, it shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines, the provisions of Republic Act No. 876, otherwise known as the "Arbitration Law" and Republic Act No. 9285 otherwise known as the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004." Provided, however, that by mutual agreement, the parties may agree in writing to resort to other alternative modes of dispute resolution.

CONFIDENTIALITY

The **CONSULTANT** acknowledges that this Contract is dependent on the *trust and confidence* reposed on him by the **PROCURING ENTITY**. He also acknowledges that, in the course of carrying out his duties under this Contract, he may receive,

be furnished with, or become privy to confidential matters concerning the transactions of the PROCURING ENTITY and/or sensitive discussions with or between PROCURING official (the "Confidential Information"). **CONSULTANT** shall not use any Confidential Information acquired under this Contract, during and even after duration of the Contract without the express written consent of the PROCURING ENTITY.

IX. **EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE RELATIONSHIP**

It is understood that this Contract does not create an employeremployee relationship between the **PROCURING ENTITY** and the **CONSULTANT**, that the services rendered hereunder are not considered and will not be accredited as government service; and that the **CONSULTANT** is not entitled to benefits enjoyed by regular personnel of the PROCURING ENTITY, unless otherwise provided by law.




