1. The Regional Research, Innovation and Development Committee (RRIDC) of Department of Education – National Capital Region (DepEd NCR) through Policy Planning and Research Division warmly congratulates the qualifiers for BERF 2020 as well as the Research Manager in Schools, Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and Regional Office.  - c. collect Memorandum of agreement (MOA) and revised research proposals both in digital and printed copies with attachments;
 - d. ensure that one month after the evaluation result was received, researchers have accomplished the online revision



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tracking form that can be accessed through this link: <http://bit.do/NCR-RP2020-REVISION> or via green QR Code as shown at your right. The form only captures details of adjustment and revision made that corresponds to the remarks as conferred by RRIDC;



- e. facilitate feedback, mentor and monitor BERF qualifiers and have it documented using the form that can be accessed through this link: <http://bit.do/R-FeedbackReport> or thru the adjacent red QR code; and



- f. inform the RRIDC if the qualifier/s has/have ongoing or pending administrative case.

4. The schedule of orientation for qualifiers and awarding of completers shall be held on April 22, 2020. Venue to be communicated on a later date. For research proposals having more than one proponent, only the lead proponent is required to attend the orientation.
5. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the DRC relative to this activity shall be charged against SDO local funds while BERF grantees are expected to have it included from their approved research proposal cost estimates subject to government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
